Dear Fairhope Churches,

Once again, for the 2009-10 season, our football team and cheerleaders will have breakfast together on game day. This means so much in helping our team win. First Baptist's Fellowship Hall will be the breakfast location. We have some renovation going on in the previous location, so that room is now smaller and not able to accommodate the team. The Fellowship Hall will be more than adequate. Several of you participated in this last year by providing food and a devotion for the breakfast. We are hoping to secure ten churches again this year so each breakfast will be covered. Ideally, we would like to see each Friday represented by a different church, so please consider serving on the date listed below. What a great way to touch a life for Christ by being involved in this ministry opportunity.

Here are the details: Coach David Faulkner, our head coach, has said we should expect about 110 people. The coaches will arrive about 6:45 a.m. and the players arrive promptly at 7:00 a.m. to be served breakfast. The menu can, of course, consist of anything you would like to prepare, but we advise you to keep it simple. In years past we have discovered that scrambled eggs, bacon, sausage, biscuits, orange juice and milk (and sometimes grits) were the easiest to prepare. Enclosed you will find a "shopping list" for this menu that is helpful. The kitchen at First Baptist will be available whatever time you need it as you will be able to go by the church and check out a key from the office. If you need to bring your supplies on Thursday to put in the freezer and refrigerator, please bring them when you come to check out the key and do so by 4:30 p.m. If you have questions about securing a key, you may call the church office at 928.8685 and speak with Sharon Pippin. Also remember, the church providing the food is asked to present a 5-10 minute inspirational message (at approximately 7:20 a.m.). After that, Coach Faulkner addresses the group. When you come to get the key, you'll be shown around our new kitchen facilities!

Fairhope High School Game Day Breakfast

Number you are planning for: 120 (mostly men and boys!!)

12 gallons of orange juice

3-4 gallons of milk

3 jars of assorted jelly (grape, strawberry, apple)

20-22 dozen eggs (**DON'T CUT THIS - you WILL run out!**)

10 packages of Southern Home or similar frozen biscuits (160 biscuits is fine)

7-8 packages of Rudy's Farm or similar brand of patty sausages (36 per pack) you'll need
around 250 patties total.

1, 5 lb. Bag of instant grits

8 sticks of butter (or tubs)

Also bring paper plates, forks, napkins and large cold cups (approx 16oz, not Styrofoam cups)
You may use the coffee pot (air pots) for making coffee at the church for the coaches and your
leadership. There are coffee condiments as well.

On Thursday of the week, come by the office of First Baptist and see Sharon to get a key and to
unload your groceries in the kitchen. She or Sandi can show you how to make coffee in the air
pots. You'll need to be sure you have time to get the tour of the new kitchen facilities.

The church providing food will also be responsible to provide a 10-minute
devotional/inspirational talk. The team is served promptly at 7:00 a.m. Devotion should begin
about 7:20 a.m.

Your group is responsible for cleaning up after the breakfast. Please clean and wipe down the
tables and take your trash out to the dumpster.
